GNTs 2016-2017: January update NO MORE \$11 SURCHARGE!

Dear District 14 members.

GNT competition is in full swing. Play in your club's qualifying games which carry a **full** sectional rating, ½ red, ½ black points

Flight B & C players qualify for unit or district finals in club-qualifying games if their team:

- 1. Wins one-half or more of their matches in a Swiss Teams (a tie is one-half of a win)
- 2. Finishes average or higher in the scoring system used to rank teams (VP or win-loss)
- 3. Finishes in the top 50% within a stratum or flight in the scoring system used

If your Unit has only one club qualification event is held, all Flight C players who participate in the event will qualify for the District Final.

Flight A and Championship flight players who play in a prior club qualifying game are automatically eligible to play in the District final. If work or travel make it impossible to play in a GNT qualifier you can "buy-in" to play in the district final (see D14 CoC).

Whether or not you want to compete in the district finals to be held in Mason City on May 6&7 you are invited to play in a special sectional to be held at the same time. (**see flyer on backside**) The price is right, the hospitality will be special too, and the 2 session Team games on Sunday will carry a regional rating with 40% more masterpoints.

The four GNT flights compete separately at the district finals. Winning teams in each flight receive \$2,000 to compete in the Summer Nationals in Toronto this July

Unlike Open events, the GNT district finals are a peer-based competition. You get to take the measure of your play vs. players of similar ability. Check the contest conditions for the relevant stratifications.
